In Memoriam Roy (Tiny) Cooney

1931- 2018

On the 7th February, we farewelled local Hermidale identity, Tiny Cooney at St Patrick's Catholic Church in Nyngan. Tiny moved to Hermidale with his family when he was 2 years old. Tiny married Alma in 1952 and they had two children, Karen and Leon who both attended Hermidale Public School. Tiny was a gun shearer and a great community member. He was involved in the Tennis Club, the Cricket Club and was President of the Combined Sports Ground for many years as well as the Hermidale Gymkhana, where he started the famous goat races over a decade ago. Boiled Chocolate Cake

Ingredients:

- 1 cup water
- 1 ½ cups sugar
- ½ teaspoon bicarb soda
- 2 tablespoons cocoa
- 125g butter
- 2 eggs, beaten
- 1 ½ cups SR flour



Method:

1. Place first five ingredients into a large saucepan.
2. Bring to the boil and simmer for 3 minutes.
3. Allow to cool slightly.
4. Add eggs and flour, stir well.
5. Pour into a greased 20cm cake pan.
6. Bake at 180 degrees celsius for 50 minutes.
7. Ice when cool if desired.
