A few reminders to ensure a smooth trip



1. Bus leaves Nyngan Railway Station at 7.30am so arrive by 7.15am
2. On Sunday, morning tea and lunch will be provided
3. We will bring the school drink bottles
4. Yes children are able to take devices on the bus with age appropriate games. Please charge devices prior to leaving and pack chargers. Devices can be used on the bus to and from the snow only. All devices will be handed to me for safe keeping during the week.
5. This week - WARM Jackets - please bring your child/rens warm jacket into school. We will pack them in a separate bag so we can easily access them from the bus when we arrive at Jindabyne.
6. Spending money must be in a snap lock bag with the child's name and amount inside . 1 bag per child please. Please don't hand me cash on Sunday morning unless it's in a labelled bag.
7. If your child requires medication, please bring it on Sunday morning. Please note - ONLY prescribed medication can be administered by the staff and medication must be in original packaging with your child's name on the label.
8. Please double check the packing list to make sure nothing has been forgotten :)
9. We have been advised that Mobile contact may be limited on the slopes and at the accommodation. If you need to speak with myself or your child, please leave a message

on my phone and I will get in touch with you. I have included the phone number for our accommodation, it is on the original note sent home. We will try to update the Hermidale PS Facebook page and send photos and videos to parents when we can!

attendance matters

The Department of Education Attendance Policy states -

Parents are required to explain the absences of their children from school promptly and within seven days to the school. An explanation for absence must be provided to the school within 7 days of the first day of any period of absence.

Attendance notes - I continue to closely monitor school attendance and assign the correct code for the absence eg sick, leave, unexplained. As such, if your child is away you are required to do the following

1. send a note explaining the reason for your child's absence. You can email the school at hermidale-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au and cc myself skye.dedman@det.nsw.edu.au OR send a written note OR text message to my mobile 0458 122 006
2. If this note has not been received on your child's return to school, a school absence note will be sent home for you to complete.
3. If a child is absent from school without prior arrangement, I will contact you via phone or message if your child is absent for more than 2 consecutive days to check.
